- 1 Contractor to provide grizzly/screen/magnetic separator as required for their pugmill operation.
 - 2 Sediment characterisation (moisture content) will be required for reagent adjustment, characterisation requirements will be determined in the OCS and SOS programs prior to construction.
 - 3 QA/QC Testing will be required to determine if the treated sediment can be transported immediately to Kooragang Island or will require temporary storage in the treated sediment storage area, QA/QC requirements will be determined in the OCS and SOS programs prior to construction.
 - 4 Oversize debris will be tested to determine if it complies with DECC April 2008 waste classification guidelines for land fill as general solid waste. Debris not meeting this requirement will be reduced in size and treated before landfill emplacement.
 - 5 Solids produced by power washing operations are treated in the stabilisation plant.
 - 6 Tyres are listed as special waste and must be disposed of according to the DECC April 2008 guidelines.
 - 7 The pathway for handling sediment will be determined by the presence or absence of oversize material. The consistency of the sediment and hours of operation for dredging and sediment treatment.
