Why is the Glenfield Precinct Plan being revised?

We are revising the Glenfield Precinct Plan following the announcement of the proposed relocation of the Hurlstone Agricultural High School to the Hawkesbury Campus of Western Sydney University. The proposed move has created an opportunity to plan for more new homes close to public transport.

What is being done to improve the transport network and connections in Glenfield?

The Department of Planning and Environment has been working with transport agencies to identify the improvements that need to be incorporated into the plan. These include:

- A new regional cycleway connecting Glenfield and Macarthur along the rail line;
- Additional kiss and ride facilities at Glenfield Station;
- Improvements to the suburban bus network and local bus services; and
- Potential regional road upgrades to improve road network connections, including several road extensions such as Cambridge Avenue.

Improvements to local pedestrian and cycling connections are also included in the plan:

- New and upgraded pedestrian and shared pathways, footpaths and lighting within the precinct; and
- 'Green links' connecting open spaces are also included in the revised plan.

What is being done about schools in Glenfield?

Existing primary schools across the Glenfield to Macarthur Urban Renewal Precincts will be expanded where appropriate, and new primary schools will be built where required, including one at Glenfield.

When will the revised plan be released?

The revised Glenfield Precinct Plan will go on public exhibition in early 2018. The Department is keen to hear your feedback on the revised plan. Community information sessions during the exhibition period in early 2018 will provide you with an opportunity to find out more about the plan.

When will the plan be finalised?

Once the public exhibition is complete, the Department will review all feedback and submissions before finalising the Glenfield Precinct Plan in mid to late 2018.
