Have your say: NSW Planning System Review coming to a town near you!

The most comprehensive review of planning legislation in three decades is about to hit the road – the Government appointed review panel is embarking on an exhaustive two-month road trip to ensure the people of NSW are heard.

Planning and Infrastructure Minister Brad Hazzard says the ambitious agenda includes 43 open forum sessions in towns from Broken Hill to Bankstown, Murwillumbah to Merimbula, and all those in between!

“For the first time in 31 years the Government is putting the entire NSW planning system up for debate, and the community will have its say on how planning should be handled in NSW,” Mr Hazzard said.

“This road show will ensure **consultation** is front and centre of the review process.

“City and country alike – we are all impacted by NSW planning laws – it’s time to let the Government know what is frustrating, formidable and failing.”

The Planning System Review is being led by former Environment Minister Tim Moore and former Public Works Minister Ron Dyer.

Following the consultation period the following will be prepared:

- Green Paper (outlining reform options)
- White Paper (detailing draft legislation)

The road show begins on **today** at Broken Hill. There will be two sessions at each location with the tour concluding in Sydney on November 14. An updated schedule is available online at www.planningreview.nsw.gov.au.

All media are invited to attend the community forums and the panel chairs will be available for interview before and after the sessions.

“The NSW Government is giving communities a once in a lifetime opportunity to have their say on a new planning system for the state.

“The Liberals and Nationals are determined to get planning right in NSW and that can only be achieved if communities voice their concerns (about current and past practices) and volunteer ideas for the future.

“This review will put NSW back on track and ensure this state is never again held back by a planning system devoid of business and community confidence,” Mr Hazzard said.
