Instrument of Delegation

I, the Minister for Planning and Public Spaces, under section 2.4 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (**the Act**), delegate my functions referred to in Column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Instrument to the officers of the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (**the Department**) holding the positions or having the roles identified in Column 3 of Schedule 1 to this Instrument.

I revoke all previous delegations of my functions the subject of this Instrument of Delegation except for the delegation of my functions under former section 59 of the Act related to the making of a local environmental plan by the Planning Assessment Commission in circumstances where former section 89E(6) of the Act applies in the Instrument of Delegation dated 14 September 2011.

Interpretation

A reference in this instrument to:

- (a) a Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Executive Director, Director, Team Leader, Manager, or Specialist Planning Officer includes a reference to any person who is temporarily assigned to the role of Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Executive Director, Director, Team Leader, Manager or Specialist Planning Officer, respectively, in the Department, and
- (b) a Secretary, Deputy Secretary, Executive Director or Director includes a reference to any person employed in senior executive band 4, senior executive band 3, senior executive band 2 or senior executive band 1 (within the meaning of the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013*), respectively, in the Department.
