1. Executive summary / introduction

CCC membership has remained relatively stable and six-monthly meetings are complemented by site visits. One community member announced his departure from the CCC after many years, due to moving out of the area. He was thanked for his service. Our alternate community representative will fill the vacant position.

Attempts to lure the CEO or another representative from the Karuah Local Aboriginal Land Council have also not been successful to date, and the LALC CEO has changed several times in the last few years. Attempts continue.

2. CCC activities over last 12 months:

- Two meetings
- Nine attended the September meeting. 3 proponent (including one consultant), 4 community, 1 group representatives, and the Chair.
- Seven attended the March meeting. 3 proponent (including one consultant), 1 community, 2 group representatives and the Council representative. Terms of reference for 2024 were agreed at this meeting.
- Two site visits with a small number of attendees each time.
- Very effective.
- Additional consultation activities related to the CCC include discussions of Modifications and neighbouring activities and proposals.

3. Key issues

No major issues were raised during the year. The main discussions were around rainfall, flooding, production, dust and noise, which are being discussed openly and environmental monitoring results are provided.

4. Focus for next 12 months:

- Two CCC meetings, each with a site visit.
- Discuss any cumulative impacts from nearby projects.
